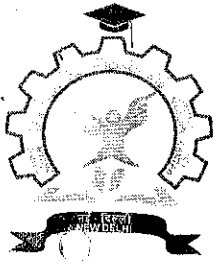

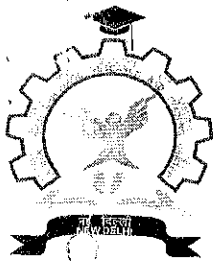

ABOUT ISLRTC, NEW DELHI

ISLRTC has been established as an autonomous body under the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India, vide order dated 28.09.2015. The Centre, presently located at Institute for Physically Handicapped, New Delhi, will have the following broad objectives :-

- i) To develop manpower for using, teaching and conducting research in Indian Sign Language (ISL) including Bilingualism (i.e. Sign Language + Writing)
- ii) To promote the use of Indian Sign Language as an Educational mode.
- iii) To carry out research through collaboration with Universities and educational institutions in India and abroad and creation of Indian Sign Language vocabulary.
- iv) To orient and train various groups, i.e. Govt. officials, Teachers, Professionals, Community leaders and the public at large for understanding and using Indian Sign Language.
- v) To promote and propagate Indian Sign Language.

Institute offers course in the field of Indian Sign Language. **Admission for the 2017-18 batch is open for following course:-**

- The filled in application form should be submitted to Indian Sign Language Research and Training Centre. The downloaded application forms should be submitted alongwith demand draft of Rs.750/- for OBC & General Category and Rs.450/- for SC/ST/PH. Demand Draft drawn in favor of "Indian Sign Language Research and Training Centre new delhi" pay at new delhi.

SCOPE, PROSPECTS AND CAREER

- Those who pursue a course of Diploma in Indian Sign Language Interpretation can expect to be a part of human resource development in Indian Sign Language.
- Diploma in Indian Sign Language Interpretation holders can work as a Interpreter, Master Trainer and also assist to Special Educator about Indian Sign Language.
- Diploma in Indian Sign Language Interpretation will be work in general(regular) schools as a Interpreter for children with hearing impairment, and also work as a resource units attached to regular schools and in Integrated Education for Disabled (IED) / District Primary Education Programme (DPEP) Schemes/SSA/RVM.
- Diploma in Indian Sign Language Interpretation holders may get employed in Government / Non – Government and Private Set up as a Interpreter.
- In view of the PWD Act (1995), UNCRPD (2008) and RPWD Act, 2016 it has become mandatory to provide interpreters for persons with hearing impairment at public utilities, schools and functions. There is an urgent requirement for sign language interpreters in the country.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE: Admissions will be made on the basis of academic qualifications required and in accordance with the prevailing rules of the ISLRTC. Seats are reserved for Scheduled Caste (SC)/ Scheduled Tribe (ST) / Other Backward Classes (OBC)/ Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates as per Central Government rules.

All admissions made will be provisional and subject to confirmation of eligibility by ISLRTC. In addition, any other documentation, if required, by the requirement in the course has to be procured by the candidate within a stipulated time for the grant of eligibility.

The original certificates submitted at the time of admission will be kept in the custody of the ISLRTC till completion of the course / confirmation of eligibility.

Merely applying for the course(s) or sponsorship of candidates does not ensure their selection/admission to courses. The Institute reserves the right of selection/rejection of an application without assigning any reason thereof. Only selected candidates are informed about their admission. No other enquiries or recommendations are entertained.

SELECTION PROCESS Selection of the candidates of DISLI course will be done by entrance test. this entrance test have the content of language(Hindi &English) creativity, reasoning , general knowledge and disability related knowledge. The question paper will be objective type and in bilingual (Hindi & English).

CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION: In case students want to withdraw after taking admission, the refund of the fees will be governed as per ISLRTC rules.

OTHER INFORMATION:

Medium of Instruction: The medium of instruction for students enrolled in diploma level courses is as per RCI norms.

Faculty: ISLRTC, in keeping with its stature as a national Institute, will invite renowned scholars from India. It will create awareness amongst students about the latest techniques and technology in their chosen field of specialization.

Attendance: Students are expected to be regular and punctual. In case the attendance of a student falls below the percentage required by the concerned university/R.C.I. Guidelines the student may not be allowed to appear for the final examination.

Student Counseling: A senior faculty member is appointed as Student Welfare Officer for all issues ranging from personal to professional. A Course-coordinator is appointed at the level of Head of Department to monitor the progress of students of course.

Sports and Cultural activities: Students are expected to participate in indoor / outdoor sports and cultural programmes to be held in the Institute as part of the Annual Day Celebrations and other important events.

RAGGING:

RAGGING IN ANY FORM WILL BE DEALT WITH AS PER RULES LAID DOWN BY THE LOCAL POLICE AUTHORITIES AND THE ISLRTC.

Discipline: Discipline has to be maintained by the students in ISLRTC. Smoking and consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited in the ISLRTC premises. Complaints are viewed seriously and action, as deemed fit, is initiated by the competent authority.

Ragging: The Institute authorities take utmost care and preventive measures have been instituted to curb the menace of ragging in the institute. An anti ragging committee will be formed comprising senior faculty and staff to counsel the students and bring to the notice of students that ragging can result in suspension, expulsion or rustication from the college, commencement of criminal proceedings and even imprisonment. All students and their parents / guardian are required, at the time of admission, to submit an affidavit that they are aware of the repercussions of ragging.
